SJ11 21/06/2018 - 09/07/2018 GALLO-ROMAN SITE OF SANXAY

Type of work: RENO, ARCH

Number of volunteers: 12

Age: 18+

Project: The Gallo-Roman site of Sanxay is one the major archaeological sites of the old province of Aquitaine. Tucked between the twist and turns of the Vonne Valley, this small village used to stretch over 25 hectares and was occupied from the 1st to the 5th century. Sanxay underwent an important development and monumental phase during the 11th century AD. The archaeological site of Sanxay is one of the best conserved ancient sites of France, and must remain so. In this regard, the Center of National Monuments asked our association to organize a workcamp there for the 3rd year in a row.

Work: This workcamp will give you the opportunity to learn the techniques of modern archaeological excavation, and to put them into practice by working on an old landyard of rubble dating back to the 19th century. The excavation will be significant because it will reveal important historical facts of the place, and it will allow us to learn how the first archaeological excavation were carried out. Therefore, the work will consist of doing an analysis of archaeology. Under the supervision of an archaeologist, you will have to remove all the grubble, clean the zone, and sort the stones. You will have to be very careful and meticulous during the clean-up, because you may find archaeological remains or objects. You will also be working with other local youth during the workcamp.

Leisure activities: You will be able to participate in the local summer events organized by the town. You will also have the opportunity to discover the region: le Marais Poitevin, La Rochelle, and Poitiers. You will also get to meet the local residents and share wonderful cultural exchange moments, as well as discover the historical and cultural heritage of the region (castles, abbeys, and a tree conservatory).

Location: Sanxay, 30 km from Poitiers

Accommodation and food: In groups, in tents on the Sanxay campground (pool, river, multi-sport areas). Meals will be prepared in turns by « kitchen teams ».

SJ12 HISTORICAL WANDERINGS IN CLAUSONNE ABBEY 3

25/06-05/07

Type of work: RENO

Number of volunteers: 12

Age: 18+

Project: Let's discover the Clausonne Abbey, a former hamlet situated at 1140 meters of altitude! You will take part to the valorization project of a place that is classified as Historical Monument. Today, only the remnants of this 12th century building are found as the abbey was destroyed, burnt, rebuilt and finally used as a farm and school in the 19th century. Clausonne remains, however, a remarkable site, sharing the beauty of the wilderness that surrounds it : situated in the heart of a vast « circus » of mountains, the abbey became the route point for numerous hikers that visit the Haute vallée of Maraize. Thus, rather than letting the vegetation once again cover

the ruins of Clausonne, 20 years ago, the inhabitants of Saix founded an association in order to highlight and maintain this site. Progressively, thanks to numerous international workcamps that have worked there, this place lives again and is currently open from April to October.

Work: In 2018, the work will concern the accessibility of the site and its visibility for hikers. You will highlight the vestiges of the pit by clearing and securing existing walls. You will make a path in the abbey's vestige and will discover the technical creation of a pebble way. You will also participate in the preservation of the carved stone.

Accommodation: In individual tents at the Faï farm. You will share this place with other volunteers from other workcamps. You will take care of the collective life (preparation of menus and meals with local products, cleaning...)

Location: Clausonne, 5km from the village of Saix, 30 km from Gap, 200 km from Marseille

Leisure activities: Located in a remarkable natural environment, Clausonne is an exceptional place to discover the pleasures of mountain hiking and life in a rural area, with its local markets and producers. In the evenings, at the Ferme du Faï, you will be able to organise games, international meals and project movies. During the workcamp, touristy visits to discover the towns and villages of the region may also be organized.

Closest train station: Veynes Dévoluy (05400). Access through the train stations of Valence TGV, Valence ville, Grenoble or Marseille Saint Charles.

Closest airports: Marseille Provence or Lyon Saint Exupéry

SJ18 THE RIVER OF VALOJOULX

07/07-28/07

Type of work: ENVI

Number of volunteers: 12

Age: 18+

Project: Nature and environmental lovers, welcome to Valojoux! This small village is located in the heart of the Vallée de l'Homme, rich in many prehistoric sites. The town is a haven of peace, dynamic and friendly population.

Work: You will work on the Turançon stream, which passes through the middle of the village: with the advice of a professional technician and the help of local volunteers, you will participate in the maintenance of the banks: size of the plants, strengthening of the banks, removal of dead wood... Intervention with hand tools is preferred: pruning shears, saws, cutting branches... to preserve this fragile environment. You will work in the mornings.

Accommodation and food: You will be welcomed in the village hall. Mattresses will be provided, showers and toilets will be available. As well as a kitchen where you can take turns preparing delicious meals.

Location: Valojoux is located in the south-west of the Dordogne, 35 km from Périgueux

Leisure activities: Swimming, canoeing, site visits, local festivals... You will be welcomed by the local population and the charm of the landscapes and their heritage through activities. Along with the leaders and the other

volunteers you can plan a program of activities (walks, swimming, canoeing on the Vézère), and take in many summer events: gourmet markets, festival of world dances...

Special requirements: You will often work with your feet in the water! Bring boots or sandals and appropriate clothing that can get wet!

Closest train station: Condat-le-Lardin station, meeting on the station at the end of the afternoon on Saturday July 7th.

Closest airport: Bordeaux-Mérignac or Toulouse-Blagnac.

SJ 20 A NEW SHELTER FOR THE EDUCATIONAL FARM

08/07 - 27/07

Type of work: CONS/ENV

Number of volunteers: 15

Age: 18+

Project: The town of Ferté Alais has a pedagogical farm which is open all year long to the local population. In July the farm organises many activities for the local youth. The farm would like to build a wood shelter in order to display some old farming machines, and to create using recycled materials more outside furniture to be able to host more people in a comfortable way. The town has had many experiences hosting international workcamps in the past. They are inviting international volunteers this summer in order to build the shelter and the furniture and connect with the local youth.

Work: As a volunteer in this camp, first you will build the wood shelter with the support of a technical leader. Then, you will discover how to build outside furniture using recycled material, like wood palettes. Once you have learned these techniques, along with local people, you will build furniture for the pedagogical farm. Through these different works, you will practice different woodwork techniques.

Accommodation and food: You will sleep in tents, in the town's former campsite, which is now used by our association to host people. Please bring a sleeping bag with you. The campsite has bathrooms and showers, as well as a kitchen space. Food will be provided and the volunteers will take turns to cook the meals.

Location: La Ferté Alais is approximately 50km south of Paris, in the Essonne region.

Leisure activities: Volunteers will have the opportunity to meet the local population and to explore the surroundings of the town. La Ferté Alais is located in a regional natural park called Gâtinais. You will also have the opportunity to enjoy the events taking place in the local community such as concerts or canoeing. Volunteers will be able to organize their own collective activities depending on their wishes and the available budget.

Closest train station: La Ferté Alais RER station. Closest airports are Paris Roissy Charles de Gaulle, Paris Orly and Paris Beauvais.

Note: This project should not be seen as a sightseeing trip to Paris. If you wish to visit Paris, you should arrive a couple days earlier or stay a couple of days after the dates of the summer camp.

Number of volunteers: 12

Age: 18+

Project : In the majestic cliffs of the Hautes-Alpes region, the organization Les Villages des Jeunes manages, animates and renovates the Faï visitor centre since 1990. The farm of Faï is situated at 1000 meters above sea level. From April to December, the association organizes workshops for local people with social and professional difficulties. And the project welcomes young people experiencing difficulties at home or at school. In summer, Faï is also a place for professional artists whose come to take advantage to create together and throw festivals which take place in Faï: FestiFaï, Echos, The Singing Mountains ... The workcamps that are organized in Faï contribute in making this site an original place where young people and adults, from many different countries and cultures, work and live together. We hope that you too, will come in this spirit of encounter and "doing together" that drives our project!

Travail : Le centre d'accueil est composé de plusieurs bâtisses, dont la maison « Auberg'in ». Ce chantier porte sur l'isolation des murs extérieurs de ce bâtiment. Vous serez accompagnés de l'encadrant technique et travaillerez ensemble pour poser un isolant naturel (paille et chaux) après avoir préparé les murs et construit une armature en bois. Par ce chantier, vous pourrez découvrir de nouvelles techniques dont celles de l'enduit traditionnel et de l'utilisation d'éco-matériaux.

Work: The reception center is composed of several buildings, including the "Auberg'in" house. This project concerns the insulation of the exterior walls of this building. You will be accompanied by a technical supervisor and work together to put a natural insulation (straw and lime) after preparing the walls and having built a wooden frame. Through this project, you will discover new techniques including those of traditional plaster and the use of eco-materials.

Accommodation and food: You will be accommodated in individual tents at the reception center of Faï, 05400 Le Saix, and will share the place with other volunteers from other sites. With the help of the leaders' team, you will be brought to participate in the collective life: developing menus, preparing meals by maximizing the purchase of local products, dishes, cleaning ...

Location: The farm of Faï (3 km from the village of Saix, 30 km from the city of Gap).

Leisure activities: Located in a remarkable natural environment, Faï is an ideal place to discover the pleasures of mountain hiking, swimming in the river and enjoying the rural life with its farmers' market and producers. In the evening, you can organize board games, screenings, international meals. Throughout the workcamp, visits to discover other touristy villages of the area can also be organised!

Closest train station : Veynes Dévoluy (05400). Access via the stations of : Valence TGV, Valence ville, Grenoble, Marseille Saint Charles.

SJ44 THE COTTAGE OF ROCHARD

17/08 - 04/09

Type of work: RENO

Number of volunteers: 9

Age: 18+

Project: The cottage is located in Béceleuf, a small village near the Poitevin Marsh, located 70 km from the Atlantic ocean, between Nantes and Bordeaux. Rochard is an old farmhouse converted into a rustic cottage by an association that hosts groups of children, hikers and campers in a yurt. This place, surrounded by nature, respects the environment and demonstrates an approach to sustainable development. Thus, various projects have been organized by the Association of Camping Club of Deux-Sevres, including the establishment of a phyto-purification tank and dry toilets adapted for communities, in the context of past international workcamps. This association is a loyal partner of Solidarité Jeunesses Poitou-Charentes, and it celebrated its 10th international workcamp in 2017!

Work: This year, the objective of the workcamp will be to continue the restoration of the cottage. You will be introduced to and trained in the techniques of traditional masonry and woodworking. These activities will be carried out under the guidance of the association's volunteers, who have vast experience with these techniques.

Accommodation and food: In a yurt next to the cottage! The food ingredients will be provided and you will take care of preparing the meals.

Location: Béceleuf, Deux-Sèvres, 20 km north of Niort

Leisure activities: Convinced by the richness of this cultural experience, hosts will organize excursions in the region and animations with the local residents, such as: visits to the Poitevin marsh, concerts, art exhibitions, and time at the swimming pool. You will also be able to visit the ocean in the towns of La Rochelle, Poitiers, Niort, etc.

Closest train station: Niort (79000)

Closest airports: Bordeaux-Mérignac or Paris
