

## **European Voluntary Service (EVS) in Germany Agapedia – Jürgen Klinsmann Foundation Centre for Children near Stuttgart**

### **About us**

The Agapedia Centre for Children is an organisation of the Agapedia – Jürgen Klinsmann Foundation network. The foundation was founded by Jürgen Klinsmann in 1995. The projects aim to encourage needy and destitute children. Four Agapedia foundations are registered in four countries (Germany, Bulgaria, Republic of Moldova and Romania).

The **Agapedia Centre for Children** is located in the medium-sized town Esslingen am Neckar in the greater area of Stuttgart (regional capital of the Federal Land Baden-Württemberg) in Southwest Germany. Children from various cultural and social backgrounds between 6 and 12 years do visit the Centre. The Centre offers meaningful activities for children, such as sports like jumping on trampoline, playing in the garden, circus and creative activities. Moreover, it offers workshops such as dancing, cooking, riding on a unicycle. Also, there are often special programs in holidays. It is a non-formal learning place. ### **Your profile**

Do you enjoy working with children? Do you have team spirit? Do you like to do organisational work? It would be fantastic, if you are a creative person and you are experienced or interested in circus activities. Ideally, you do have at least some basic knowledge in German and/or you can speak English.

### **Your tasks at the Agapedia Centre for Children**

- Activities with children such as handicrafts and creative actions, circus, homework support and sports activities
- Support the holiday programmes
- Help to organise charity events
- Administrative and organisational tasks

You will cooperate closely with the Agapedia team. If you need support, you will get some, but you will also have free space for your own ideas.

### **What are your conditions?**

You can start your EVS in **September 2016** (or latest in December 2016) for **ideally 12 months**.

The **EVS is funded by a EU programme**. Therefore, you will receive a monthly pocket money. Moreover, accommodation, beverage as well as travel costs will be paid for you. INEX, our Czech partner organisation will help to organise your travel. You will be accommodated in a shared living apartment at the Agapedia house. INEX will do some preparatory activities. During your stay in Germany, you will participate in accompanying seminars and online language courses.

### **Application and selection procedure**

Please, do send your CV and a motivation letter to us (see email address below) **by 22<sup>nd</sup> July 2016**. If we like your application, we will invite you for a Skype interview. Afterwards, we will decide if you can do your voluntary service at Agapedia.
